* **All cast members must help out with costumes, playbill placement, props, or set construction.** Cast members must also assist with set strike. **The show is not over till strike is completed!**

* To successfully produce a show we need many volunteers. We actually need more crew members than cast members. **Please consider joining the production crew.** You will have a wide choice of work, learn new skills, and have a great time!
